

Health Camps: Providing Care and Hope

Our bi-monthly health camps have been a cornerstone of our commitment to the community's well-being. In 2024, we successfully organized over six health camps, and we are continuing this initiative in 2025. Held every first Sunday of every two months, these camps offer free general health check-ups, dental exams, and eye screenings. With the support of volunteer doctors and nurses, as well as Lions Club of Baltimore Nepalese and Narayan Khakurel for eye care management, we have been able to provide prescription refills and write necessary medical prescriptions. This program has been a lifeline for many in our community, and we are deeply grateful to the medical professionals who have selflessly contributed their time and expertise.

Buwa Aama Sanga BANA: Honoring Our Elders

Our monthly program "Buwa Aama Sanga BANA," launched in 2024, has been a resounding success. Conducted in coordination with the Baltimore County Aging Department, this initiative brings together elderly parents visiting the U.S. or residing here permanently. Over the past year, we have organized activities such as movie screenings, entertainment sessions, and social gatherings, creating a space for connection, joy, and engagement. This program continues to grow in popularity and has become a cherished event for our senior members.



Cultural Preservation Through Dance

Since 2022, BANA has been running weekly dance classes at our community center every Sunday. These classes provide Nepalese children with an opportunity to learn traditional Nepali dance and music, fostering cultural pride and preserving our heritage. With dedicated teachers and enthusiastic students, this program has become a vibrant reflection of our commitment to cultural preservation.

- Dashain and Tihar Program: Joyous celebrations of Nepal's biggest festivals, uniting families and friends in festive spirit.
